- (h) *"I witnessed hundreds of people being scammed and hurt by Sturgis"*
- (i) *"Ray's son was just convicted of a terrible crime"*
- (j) *"I know there is a lawsuit in Arizona against Raymond Sasseville"*
- (k) *"If you are approached for sponsorship, support, vendors booths, or admission tickets, I urge only one thing – inform and educate yourself about who everyone is that is at the table, learn about them and make your own decision from there." – NO*

42. The Defendant Charbonneau, published a Belt Drive Betty's blog – *The laughable part is someone being convicted of sexual assault and you using it against the organizers of Sturgis North. I can only assume this asshole is related to an organizer but it has nothing to do with Sturgis North. As far as people being scammed and defrauded of money, there are legal avenues for them to take and I certainly hope that those effected at exploring those avenue. You might want to seek some counseling to help you move on from Sturgis North experiences."*

43. The statements in paragraphs 41 and 42 are libelous and defamatory. (the "Libelous Statements")

44. By way of innuendo, the Libelous Statements contain words such as "fraud" which implies that the Plaintiffs are involved in unlawful/criminal conduct.

45. By way of innuendo by publishing the Libelous Statements, the Defendant Charbonneau maliciously intended to degrade, defame, and unlawfully spread and publish unfounded false allegations on the World Wide Web, and in the Busted Knuckles Chronicles.
